

HE CAME FROM THE TRIBE OF JUDAH

Foretold

*The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet,
until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.* Gen 49:10 NIV

Jacob was on his deathbed. Reuben, the oldest son, was seen to be unworthy because of great sin to receive the authority usually given to the firstborn, and this honor was passed on to Judah. He was the fourth in the line, likened to a lion cub by his soon-to-die father. All the twelve sons stood around the aged Jacob as he blessed his grieving family before his passing. Jacob was indeed frail and so weak that day, but knew his sons well.
